At the <u>REDAS Mid-Autumn Festival held on 20 September at Orchard Hotel</u> Singapore, Guest-of-Honour Dr Tan See Leng, Minister for Manpower and Second Minister for Trade & Industry announced that <u>MOM will extend the waiver of foreign worker</u> levies for all <u>S</u> Pass and Work Permit holders, including Migrant Domestic Workers (MDW), for the duration of their Stay-Home Notice (SHN), till December 2021. With the extension, employers with workers serving their SHN from January to December 2021 will not be required to pay levies for their workers for the duration of the SHN.
