Relaunch Of The URA Architectural Heritage Awards

URA is pleased to announce the launch of the revised Architectural Heritage Awards (AHA) scheme. The revised scheme aims to:

- Make AHA more inclusive and relevant to the wider public;
- Accord recognition to more areas of expertise and variety of stakeholders;
- Consider not just technical excellence, but expand emphasis on the intangible outcomes of creating long-term value for the community;
- Encourage sustained efforts in the upkeep and management of heritage buildings.

The scheme will now be also open to projects with 'partial restoration'. Deserving projects will be conferred a Special Mention.

The Awards will also now give recognition to more stakeholders and allied professionals (e.g. master carpenter, glass restorer, landscape architect etc.), in addition to Building Owner, Architect, C&S Engineer, Contractor and Conservation Specialist.

A new submission template will be introduced to facilitate applicants in their submission. The call for submissions will happen in March/April 2022.
