## WHAT IS TICP?

TICP is a newly established panel to drive closer partnership between LTA and the built-environment industry in the plan submission process. TICP will review rules and processes that will benefit both LTA and the industry.

TICP also aims to help the industry improve competency and submission quality.

TICP comprises representatives from IES, REDAS and SIA, and is chaired by the Chief Executive of LTA, Mr Ng Lang.

The TICP has started working on various new initiatives and future directions. Some of these new initiatives are illustrated below. More details will be announced progressively as the TICP develops the proposals.

## NEW INITIATIVES IN 2021

### LTA-SIA/IES CO-CREATION SERIES

A co-solutioning forum to jointly identify pain points and find solutions, with a focus on technical and design aspects. Four specialised workgroups for roads/parking, TIA processes, rail/infrastructure and active mobility have met and will develop solutions such as a guide for designing of spaces for bulky delivery and checklist for Active Mobility requirements.



### EXPANSION OF LODGEMENT SCHEME (BY 2H2021)

i) Lodgement for simple projects (e.g. covered linkways, minor A&A) in the Rails Protection Zone.

ii) Expansion of lodgement to single-use farm developments for street works



### INDUSTRY SEMINARS

As the last seminar on commuter facilities in Dec 2020 was well received, LTA will be organising seminars more frequently. The next seminar focuses on Rapid Transit System (RTS) regulations and will be held around Aug 2021. The TICP will discuss ways to improve the content and delivery of these seminars.



### PUBLICATION OF QUICK GUIDES

A quick guide on the relocation of manholes and a step-by-step guide on application of waivers has been published on LTA website to help QPs. More guides on other aspects with inputs from industry associations will also be published.



### OTHER UPCOMING INITIATIVES
