

Fire Safety of Electric Vehicles - Regulatory Requirements & Best Practices For adoption In the Built Environment

ABSTRACT

Singapore government has embarked on a series of plans to adopt in phases, electric vehicles (EV) to reduce land transportation emissions. This includes providing incentives for EV registration and ownership, developing island-wide charging networks, preparing towns for EV adoption, to developing regulatory codes and safety standards.

However, the technology behind EVs have also drawn great interest, debate and concerns from regulators, research community, manufacturers, property developers, vehicle owners and public etc. because of the risks posed by and to such vehicles.

This engagement session aims to discuss issues relating to EVs such as the risks and causes of fires, preventive and mitigating approaches as well as the regulatory requirements for adoption in our built environment.
